Guidelines

- 1.** The competition is open to all Indian school students of class X, XI and XII only.
- 2.** International students with Indian origin are also eligible to submit.
- 3.** Essays should be neatly typed in English language between 300 words to 500 words in length (Times New Roman font 12, spacing 1.5).
- 4.** Essays written using AI tools or from any other sources will not be considered for evaluation. Plagiarism less than 10% is accepted.
- 5.** Submissions must be sent as pdf/doc format.
- 6.** Essays will be judged based on creativity, originality and clarity of expression and in-depth insight into the topic by Space Scientists and AeSI Executive committee members.
- 7.** All participants will be awarded with a certificate of appreciation.
- 8.** Top 10 essays will feature in our division magazine.
- 9.** Top three Winners will get a free chance to attend an International Conference with space scientists.
- 10.** Schools with more than 25 submissions will be awarded a special prize.
- 11.** The decision of the judges will be final.
- 12.** Submissions made after the due date will not be considered for evaluation.
